

Dome of the Palace of Lords

The dome is part of large reconstruction project of historic monument: the Palace of the Grand Duchy of Lithuania.

The palace (also designed by PST) consists of four blocks with an enclosed yard.

The total area of the cellars, three storeys and attic exceeds 10 000 square meters.

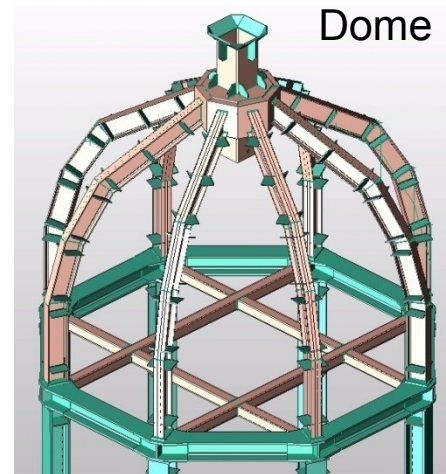
The dome connects the existing Cathedral building with the Palace ensemble. The dome has 7 tons of steel.

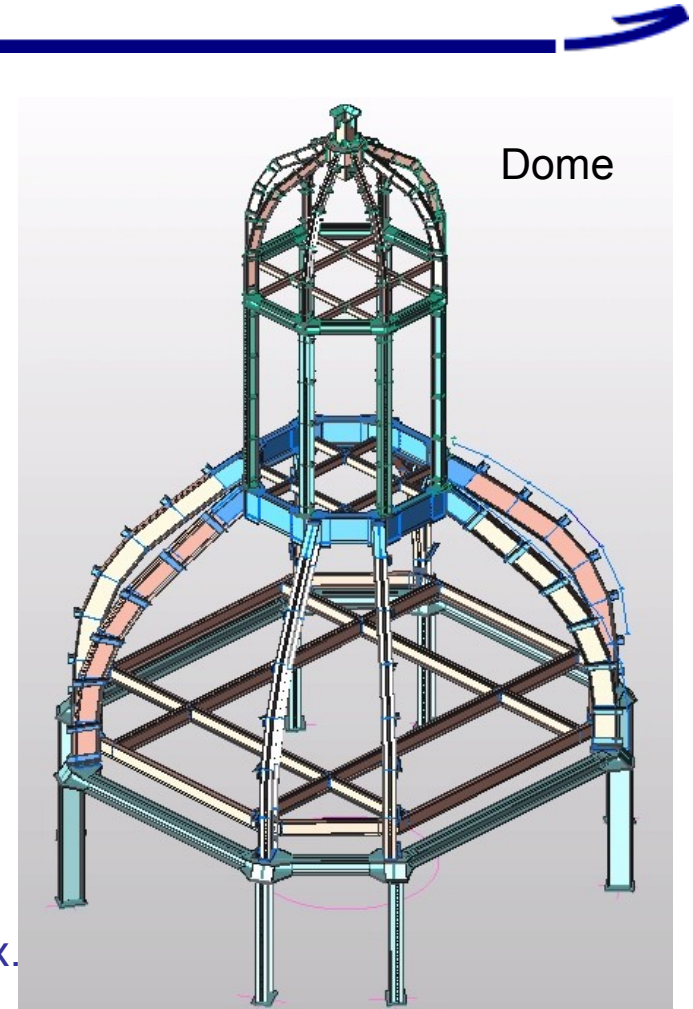
Dome of the Palace of Lords
